Our Pomology & Viticulture program presents new cultivars of table grapes, peaches, nectarines, apples, plums, quince, Asian pears, and other alternative fruits and offers tastings to participants.

Kick-off with fruit research and production, modern orchard systems, visiting several fruit-industry commercial booths.

Explore projects on Fuji and Honeycrisp apple irrigation, fruit nutrition, chemigation, chemical and hand thinning, and safe use of pesticide and herbicide, for safe and healthy consumption, without environmental pollutions.

Almond and walnut research and potential of these new fruit crops for major commercial production in Idaho.

Tour of the use of new rootstocks and canopy architectures in modern pedestrian cherry orchards.

**Who can come?**

All are welcome, including those interested in fruit production: commercial growers, small farm growers, alternative fruit growers, home gardeners, Master gardeners, horticultural professionals and graduate students, Extension and research faculty/staff, horticultural hobbyists, and fruit industry representatives are welcome.

Two Pesticide Credits will be offered to those who attend the entire field day.

- Directions from Boise/Caldwell:  
Take I-84 West. Take US20/26 Exit 26 toward Notus/Parma. Turn left onto Hwy 20/26 and continue for 18.0 mi. Turn right onto Pearl Rd and go 1 mi. Turn right on Parma Rd and go approx.0.2 mi. Orchards and vineyards will be on the right.
- Directions from Parma R & E Center:  
North on U of I Lane 0.4 mi. Turn right onto Klahr and continue for 0.4 mi. Turn left onto Parma Road and continue for 1.8 mi. Orchard/vineyards will be on the left
- Registration starts at 8:30 a.m. at the Pomology Orchard and Vineyard site. Program starts at 9 a.m.
